I loved in the summer and fall watching Arto driving a tractor to cut and gather the hay Then together with the tractor bringing the beautiful smelling fresh hay bales for the winter quickly being surrounded by the buffalo. The

horses and the cows had to wait their turn. The buffalo were always shooing them off, then all of them followed the tractor to the next drop off, where we got out to unravel the twine for them.

I loved knowing that all around us in the bushes were the ever curious coyotes, wolves, bears, dear, moose, weasels. squirrels, pack rats, marmots, lynx, beavers, foxes, owls and eagles fascinated by our comings and goings. I loved picking out all their prints in the snow. I loved when my nine chickens

I loved watching my pristine drinking water bubbling forth from underground springs year around. I loved knitting and reading in the candlelight. The candles that l made and gave as gifts.
